Section 8. Ground Maintenance.

- (a). No grading, leveling, or excavating upon a burial space shall be allowed without the prior written permission of the Township Supervisor or cemetery sexton.
- (b). No flowers, shrubs, trees or vegetation of any type shall be planted without the prior written approval of the Township Supervisor or cemetery sexton. Any of the foregoing items planted without such approval may be removed by the Township or the cemetery sexton.
- (c). The Township reserves the right to remove or trim any tree, plant or shrub located within a township cemetery that hinders the use of a lawn mower or other gardening apparatus.
- (d). All mounds which hinder the use of a lawn mower or other gardening apparatus are prohibited.
- (e). The Township or cemetery sexton shall have the right and authority to remove and dispose of any and all growth, emblems, displays or containers therefor that through decay, deterioration, damage or otherwise become a source of litter or a maintenance problem.
- (f). Ground surfaces other than earth or sod, such as stones, bark, or wood chips, are prohibited.
- (g). All refuge of any kind or nature, including but not limited to dried flowers, wreaths, papers and flower containers must be removed from the cemetery or deposited in containers located within the cemetery for that purpose.

ADENDUM TO SECTION 8: (f) The spreading of cremated ashes is prohibited in Dunsmore and Morehouse Cemeteries.
