

Echo Township / Six Mile Lake Special
Assessment Hearing Minutes
May 4, 2023

The Hearing held at 1720 6 Mile Lake Rd. East Jordan, Michigan called to order at 7:00pm by Supervisor Derenzy. Echo Township Board members present, Diane Kucharek, William Derenzy, Alan Petrie, Robert Hott and Dennis Graham. Four guests were in attendance, one from PLM, one from South Arm Township and two from Echo Township. Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

2022 minutes were distributed to all in attendance. Motion by Petrie to approve minutes; supported by Hott. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report reviewed by all in attendance. Motion by Graham to approve Treasurer's report; supported by Petrie. Motion carried.

Derenzy stated the reason for this hearing is to hear any comments about the Six Mile Lake Special Assessment in Echo Township; all questions are welcome.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Residents were glad to see the reduced per parcel assessment and would like the Special Assessment to continue.

NEW BUSINESS: Both Echo Township residents voted to continue with the Assessment.

The new 2023 PLM contract has a maximum to spend of \$17,000. The 2023 assessment currently totals \$6,100. Derenzy stated the carryover from 2022 is \$31,550.85.

2023 assessment has been set at \$50.00 per water front parcel, with indirect lake access at \$5.56; total spread for 2023 is \$6,100.00.

Resolution #7 of 2023 offered by Hott, supported by Graham, confirming Special Assessment Roll for Six Mile Lake Special Assessment District project should be continued and a contract should be made with PLM Lake & Land Management Corp. not to exceed \$17,000.00.
