January minutes presented by Kucharek. Motion by Hott to approve minutes; supported by Graham. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report reviewed by the board. Motion by Graham to approve Treasurer's report; supported by Kucharek. Motion carried.

Guest Speakers:

- 1) Update from township resident who voiced concern at the January meeting regarding the truck traffic on Vance Road between Kidder and Graham Roads. He spoke with Chris at the sawmill; felt Chris was genuinely concerned and mentioned that the truckers are independent. If possible, let Chris know the truckers name and/or color of their cab and he will speak to them. County was to trim the trees so the truckers could stay on their own side. Sawmill wants to be good neighbors and are willing to help resolve this issue. Supervisor Derenzy spoke to Burt with the AC Road Commission:
 - a) Mentioned the trees over-hanging the road Burt will have his supervisor look into it.

- Burt (ACRC) mentioned that Kidder Road will most likely be pushed out another two years from the already projected five-year plan.

• Unable to reach resident on Muckle Road regarding flooding issue. Messages were left. Burt (ACRC) will look at it this spring.
