Also attended recent meeting regarding the Brownfield Project Plan – voiced concern regarding the 30-year tax abatement they were awarded. **(3)** Resident questioned federal funding released for road repairs – what area? Supervisor will reach out to Antrim County Road Commissioner and see if he has any information.

Clerk to contact several fencing companies to receive quotes on repairing the chain fence behind the hall. Treasurer contacted Great Lakes Energy regarding the mess they left at the Township Park; they will be back in the spring to repair the damage done to the right-of-way.
